### FIRST READING

Isaiah 50:4-7

I did not cover my face against insult and I know I will not be ashamed.

The Lord has given me a disciple's tongue.

So that I may know how to reply to the wearied he provides me with speech. Each morning he wakes me to hear, to listen like a disciple.

The Lord has opened my ear.

For my part, I made no resistance, neither did I turn away.

#### REFLECTION ....

Today's description of Palm Sunday in Mark (11:1-10) marks the triumphant entry into Jerusalem of Jesus, together with his disciples. Jesus rides on a donkey borrowed for the occasion to fulfil an existing prophecy. "Shout for joy...Jerusalem...see your king shall come to you...a just saviour...riding on a colt" (Zechariah 9:9). Some of those watching spread their cloaks and place branches from the fields on the road calling out 'hosannas' in loud voices by way of greeting. Mark's version is mostly descriptive of a joyous occasion, but in John (12:12-16) more attention is paid to those who witness the event. They include the chief priests who are dismayed by the fervour with which Jesus is followed. The story of the raising of Lazarus preceded the entry into Jerusalem and the authorities were growing increasingly concerned as to the disruptive effect Jesus was having on the populace. They were soon to act. For Jesus, however, this marked the beginning of his journey to the cross. As the Easter journey unfolds in coming days, it is interesting to reflect on the state of mind of Jesus at this stage-was he full of uncertain apprehension or filled with dread about the inevitability of what was to follow? **Carmel White**
